HMCS Orkney	River Class Frigate	April 18, 1944	Paid off January 22, 1946	Named to honour Yorkton, but to avoid confusion with HMS York & USS Yorktown
HMCS Poundmaker	River Class Frigate	September 17, 1944	Paid off November 25, 1945	Named to honour North Battleford, but to avoid confusion with HMCS Battleford
HMCS Qu'Appelle (I)	River Class Destroyer	February 8, 1944	Paid off May 27, 1946	Ex HMS Foxhound named for the River rather than the Town
HMCS Qu'Appelle (II)	MACKENZIE Class Destroyer Escort	September 14, 1963	Paid off March 28, 1994	Named for the River rather than the Town
HMCS Regina (I)	Flower Class Corvette	January 22, 1942	Torpedoed & sunk off Trevoze Head, Cornwall August 8 , 1944 with loss of thirty lives	
HMCS Regina (II)	HALIFAX Class Frigate	September 3, 1994	In service	
HMCS Rosthern	Flower Class Corvette	June 17, 1941	Paid off July 19, 1945	
HMCS Saskatchewan (I)	River Class Destroyer	May 31, 1943	Paid off January 28, 1946	Ex HMS Fortune named for the River rather than the Province.
HMCS Saskatchewan (II)	MACKENZIE Class Destroyer Escort	February 16, 1963	Paid off December 3, 1993	Named for the River rather than the Province
HMCS Saskatoon (I)	Flower Class Corvette	June 9, 1941	Paid off June 25, 1945	
HMCS Saskatoon (II)	KINGSTON Class Maritime coastal Defense Vessel	December 5, 1998	In service	Ship's sponsor is the Hon. Sylvia Fedoruk former Lieutenant Governor of Saskatchewan
HMCS Swift Current	BANGOR Class Minesweeper	November 11, 1941	Paid off October 23, 1945	
HMCS Waskesiu	River Class Frigate	June 16, 1943	Paid off January 26, 1946	Named to honour Prince Albert but to avoid confusion with HMS Prince Albert
HMCS Weyburn	Flower Class Corvette	November 26, 1941	Mined and sunk off Gibraltar February 22, 1943 with loss of seven lives.
